"Scarecrow Math".

SCARECROW MATH

You get to choose what type of problem you want your students to solve.

Each "Scarecrow Math" problem solves an addition, subtraction, multiplication or division problem!

This lesson is easy to differentiate depending upon the assessed math skills of the child.

Appropriate for Grades K-3

Each child can create any of the following types of word problems:

Addition - Add all the scarecrows on the page. Add all the pumpkins on the page.

Subtraction - Draw a crow eating the pumpkins to subtract pumpkins.

Division- Dividing the pumpkins being protected from the crows by a scarecrow of their own solves the division problem.

Multiplication - Multiplying the pumpkins around each scarecrow solves the multiplication problem.

The student writes the word problem on the paper.

Materials:

- Free "Scarecrow Math" template
- Scissors
- Green or yellow construction paper
- Crayons
- Glue
- Orange glitter (optional)
